-To avoid interruptions consider an external power or USB battery and turn off phone/remove sim card to avoid phone call interrupting recording. -Find source of natural light and that all unneeded/unnatural lights are turned off.

-Place art in the south

-Place camera in the north

-Consider recording during sunset

-Record using timelapse

-Shoot for one hour

All files must be unedited. File size under 100mb and MP4 and length no longer than 2 minutes.
